STATE-LEVEL MOCK EXERCISE ON FLOOD DISASTER

Date: 19.12.2024

A State-Level Mock Exercise on flood disaster (preparedness) was successfully organized in Cachar District by the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) in collaboration with the Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA) and the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA).

The exercise simulated a bridge collapse scenario at Bhaga Bazar under Sonai Revenue Circle, testing the coordinated response of all line departments and central agencies. The drill aimed to evaluate the readiness and efficiency of disaster management protocols in addressing critical situations.

Representatives from multiple agencies from state Govt departments/agencies, including the Army, Assam Rifles, CRPF and the Border Security Force (BSF), participated actively in the exercise. The scenario involved real-time resource mobilization, evacuation measures, first aid, and communication strategies.

Following the drill, a debriefing session was conducted online, where stakeholders analyzed the exercise outcomes. Observers from the Indian Army and BSF shared their independent observations and offered valuable suggestions to enhance the disaster response framework.

The event highlighted the importance of multi-agency coordination in disaster management and underscored the need for periodic drills to ensure preparedness for real-life emergencies.

Cachar DC advocates collaborative efforts for disaster risk reduction & HIV/AIDS prevention at North East Development Conclave

SILCHAR In a strategic move to address two critical issues affecting the region, Cachar District Commissioner Mridul Yadav called for a collaborative approach to disaster risk reduction and HIV/AIDS prevention at the North East Development Conclave (DORR) held in Silchar on Friday. The event, organized in partnership with the District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA), Cachar and Impact Weaver Pvt. Ltd., aimed to foster cooperation among government bodies, NGOs, and private entities to build resilient communities and enhance public health.

Yadav emphasized the importance of partnerships to bolster risk management and climate adaptation, highlighting the role of NGOs in supporting government-led initiatives. "To achieve tangible and concrete outcomes in disaster management and climate adaptation, we must work hand-in-hand with NGOs. Their grassroots experience, combined with government resources, can significantly contribute to building resilient communities," Yadav said.

Cachar CEO and Additional Deputy Commissioner Yubaraj Borthakur echoed these views, underscoring the role of technology in driving development. "Technology must be at the core of our developmental initiatives.
