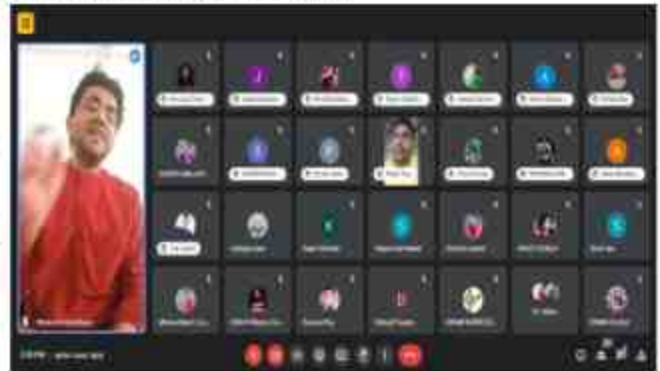

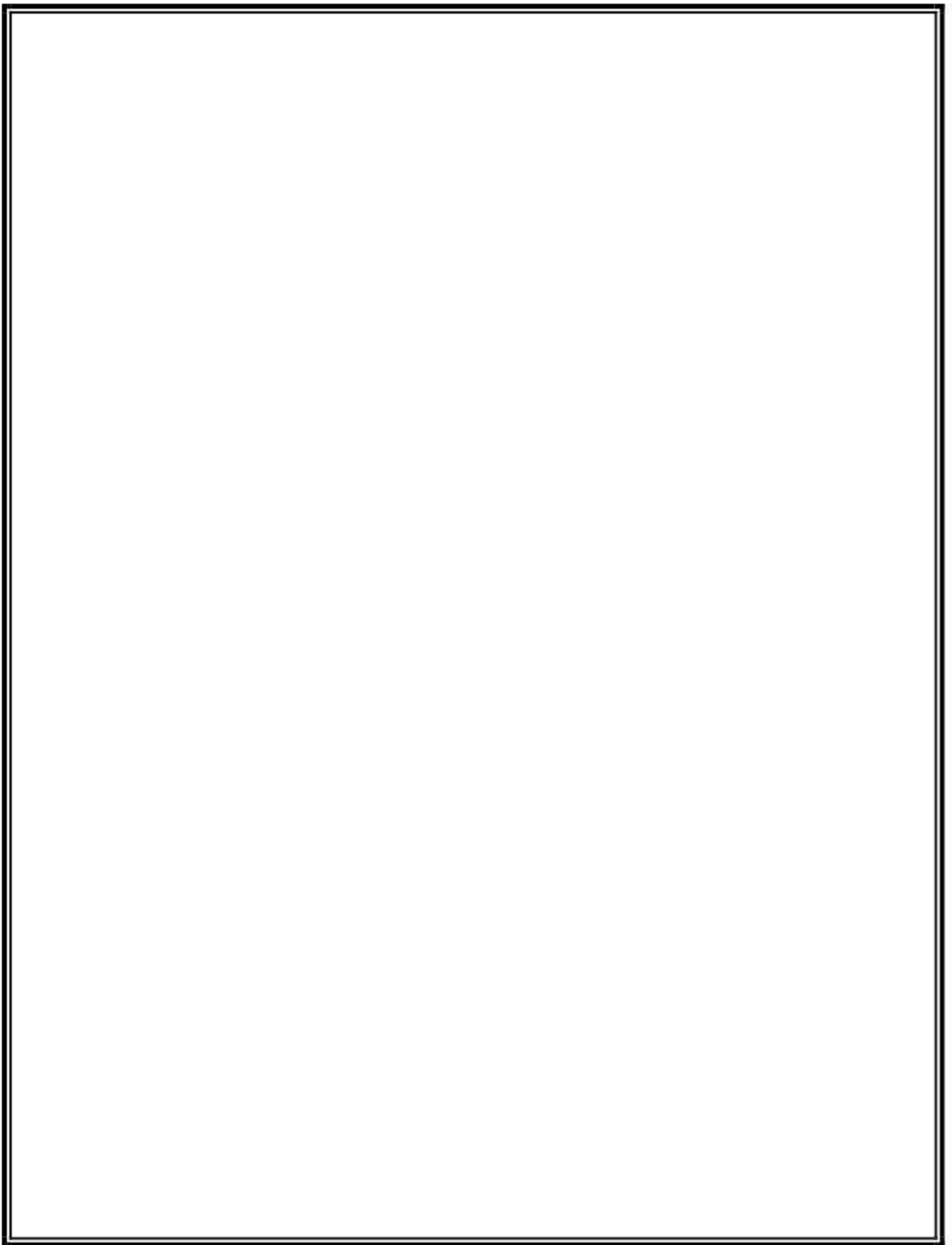

পরীক্ষায় সফল হলেও নাগরিকদের সঙ্গে যোগাযোগ করে দু'দিনের মধ্যে রিপোর্ট পাঠাবে কাছাড় ডিডিএমএ।

দুর্যোগে নাগরিকদের নিরাপত্তা ও সুরক্ষা সুনিশ্চিত করতে একটি সেল ব্রডকাস্ট সতর্কতা সিস্টেম পরীক্ষামূলকভাবে পরিচালনা করা হবে সোমবার। জাতীয় দুর্যোগ ব্যবস্থাপনা কর্তৃপক্ষের সহযোগিতায় এই পরীক্ষা চলবে।

দুর্যোগের প্রাকমুহূর্তে জরুরি যোগাযোগ ব্যবস্থা উন্নত করা ও নাগরিকদের কাছে সচেতনতামূলক বার্তা প্রেরণের উদ্দেশ্যেই এই অভিনব কৌশল গ্রহণ করা হয়েছে।

কাছাড় ডিডিএমএ সূত্রে জানা গেছে, দুর্যোগের ভয়াবহতা ঠেকাতে আধুনিক প্রযুক্তিকে কাজে লাগিয়ে নাগরিকদের সুরক্ষিত রাখার প্রয়াস চালানো হচ্ছে। দেশের প্রত্যেক নাগরিকের সুরক্ষার কথা মাথায় রেখে মোবাইল ফোন ব্যবহারকারীর ওপর সেল ব্রডকাস্ট অ্যালার্ট সিস্টেমের পরীক্ষা করা হচ্ছে। জরুরি সতর্কবার্তা সম্প্রচার করার কার্যকারিতা খতিয়ে দেখার জন্য এই পরীক্ষাগুলি দেশের বিভিন্ন অঞ্চলে সময়ে সময়ে করা হবে। অসমে এই পরীক্ষা চলবে সোমবার।

সূত্রটি জানিয়েছে, সেল ব্রডকাস্ট অ্যালার্ট সিস্টেম হল একটি অত্যাধুনিক প্রযুক্তি যা সাধারণ মানুষকে একটি নির্দিষ্ট ভৌগোলিক এলাকার মধ্যে সমস্ত মোবাইল ডিভাইসে দুর্যোগ ব্যবস্থাপনার জন্য জটিল এবং সময়-সংবেদনশীল বার্তা পাঠাতে সক্ষম হবে। দুর্যোগ সংক্রান্ত গুরুত্বপূর্ণ ও জরুরি তথ্য যথাসময়ে মানুষের কাছে যাতে পৌঁছে যায়, তার ব্যবস্থাই নেওয়া হচ্ছে।

সরকারি সংস্থা এবং জরুরি পরিষেবাগুলি যাতে সম্ভাব্য হুমকি সম্পর্কে জনসাধারণকে অবহিত করতে পারে এবং গুরুতর পরিস্থিতিতে তাদের সচেতন হওয়ার বার্তা দিতে পারে, এরজন্য সেল ব্রডকাস্ট ব্যবহৃত হয়। প্রতিকূল আবহাওয়ার সতর্কতা যেমন সুনামি, ফ্লাশ ফ্লাড, ভূমিকম্প সহ অন্য দুর্যোগে জনসাধারণকে নিরাপত্তার বার্তা, বিপর্যস্ত এলাকা থেকে সুরক্ষিত স্থানে স্থানান্তরিত হওয়ার বার্তা দেওয়া সম্ভব হবে টেলি যোগাযোগ ও জাতীয় দুর্যোগ ব্যবস্থাপনা কর্তৃপক্ষের এই পদক্ষেপে।

এদিকে, অ্যালার্ট সিস্টেমের পরীক্ষা চলাকালীন নাগরিকদের মোবাইলে বার্তা পৌঁছবে। এই সতর্কবার্তা পরিকল্পিত পরীক্ষার প্রক্রিয়ার অংশ। ফলে কাউকে বিভ্রান্ত না হওয়ার আহ্বান জানানো হয়েছে।

অন্যদিকে, রাজ্যজুড়ে এই পরীক্ষা চলাকালীন কাছাড় তথা শিলচরে কতজন এমন সতর্কবার্তা পেয়েছেন, তা খতিয়ে দেখবে জেলা দুর্যোগ ব্যবস্থাপনা কর্তৃপক্ষ। নাগরিকদের সঙ্গে যোগাযোগ করে এক প্রতিবেদন তৈরি করা হবে। আগামী দু'দিনের মধ্যে সেই প্রতিবেদন জাতীয় দুর্যোগ ব্যবস্থাপনা কর্তৃপক্ষের কাছে প্রেরণ করা হবে বলে জানা গেছে।

ASSAM DRR ROADMAP 2030

Cachar DDMA employs strategy to reduce disaster losses & impacts faced by district

SILCHAR: The District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) of Cachar, in collaboration with the Assam State Disaster Management Authority (ASDMA) and technical support from UNICEF, conducted a comprehensive two-day workshop on the Assam Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) Roadmap 2030. The event took place at the Rangpur Dey's Hotel Conference Hall near Silchar IOCL Depot.

The inaugural session, presided over by Assistant District Commissioner and CEO of Cachar, Yuvraj Barthakur, brought together District and State resource persons. The workshop saw the active participation of 60 officials from line departments, heads of various departments, nodal officers, DPO DDMA Cachar, and FOS. The workshop aimed to



deepen the understanding of the Assam DRR Roadmap 2030, covering its salient features, architecture, key sectoral DRR activities, and monitoring framework to achieve long-term resilience.

Practical sessions on DRR project formulation were conducted, with participants organized into five thematic groups: Resilient Social Service Infrastructure, Resilient Critical Infrastructure, Resilient

Livelihoods, Resilient Cities, and Resilient Emergency Response Systems.

Insightful presentations on the five key thematic areas of the DRR Roadmap 2030 were delivered by resource persons Mukund Upadhyay from UNICEF Assam, Kishore Dutta from ASDMA, DPO Cachar Shamim Ahmed Laskar, and DRR Consultant Dr. Rajeev Gupta.

The Chief Executive Officer of DDMA, Yuvraj Barthakur,

chaired the mock project development exercise, providing valuable guidance on key elements of project formulation, emphasizing risk analysis, stakeholder mapping, cost-benefit analysis, and the key principles of 'do not harm' and 'build better'.

The workshop is set to be implemented in Cachar district using a cascading model, enabling line departments to develop need-based projects aligned with the Assam DRR Roadmap 2030. These projects will be integrated into their annual plans, focusing on the most vulnerable communities, infrastructure, and assets. This approach is part of DDMA's strategy to gradually reduce overall disaster losses and impacts faced by the district. The workshop concluded with closing remarks by CEO Yuvraj Barthakur, and certificates of participation were awarded to all workshop attendees.
