BORAKHAI HIGH SCHOOL TAKES THE LEAD IN Solid Waste Management Awareness

In a significant step towards environment consciousness, Borakhai High School, near NIT Silchar, hosted an awareness program on Solid Waste Management (SWM) and inaugurated a plastic bank which was later installed in the school premises

A joint initiative by District Disaster Management Authority (DDMA) Cachar, and ONGC Cachar forward Base Srikona, which garnered substantial support from the community, with Shib Durga Club backing the cause.

EMPOWERING COMMUNITIES:

District-Level Meeting on Disaster Risk Reduction

On the occasion of the International Day for Disaster Risk Reduction (IDDRR), a significant District-Level Multi-stakeholder meeting was organized at the Conference Hall of Hotel J.C. International in Silchar. The focus of the gathering was on improving access to shock-responsive entitlements, bringing together various line departments, NGOs, and volunteers from Cachar District

The program was a collaborative effort organized jointly by DDMA Cachar, UNICEF Assam, IAG Cachar, and Deshobondhu Club. The event aimed to enhance coordination among stakeholders for more effective disaster response and recovery.

The meeting delved into detailed discussions on shock-responsive social protection schemes, emphasizing on the importance of ensuring the continuity of livelihoods during emergencies. Various topics, including Women & Child Centric social protection entitlements, SDRF Norms, and the Importance of CBDRM (Community-Based Disaster Risk Management), were covered.

The series of discussions concluded with appreciation from all participants, commending DDMA Cachar for its proactive initiatives and efforts. The collaborative nature of the meeting showcased a unified commitment to disaster resilience and community well-being.





A significant District-Level Multi-stakeholder consultation unfolded today in the Conference Hall of Hotel J.C. International in Silchar. This session focused on Risk-Informed Child and Women Friendly GPDPs and brought together ZP/AP Members, GP Presidents, PRI members, and Nodal Officers of CFRC's in collaboration with DDMA Cachar, UNICEF-Assam, IAG Cachar, and Deshobondhu Club

Key Initiatives:

The program commenced with an introduction by the District Project Officer of DDMA Cachar, outlining the critical role of CFRC in fostering Women & Child Friendly GPDPs. The consultation aimed to strengthen risk-informed practices for the well-being of children and women in the community.

In-Depth Discussions:

Detailed discussions with PRI members from 20 GPs covered various aspects, including Shock-Responsive Social Protection schemes, Women & Child-friendly GPDPs, and Social protection entitlements for flood-vulnerable populations.

Active Participation:

Pro-active participation was encouraged among the stakeholders to address potential challenges that may rise during disaster response and recovery.

Group Discussions and Appreciation:

Group discussions with PRI members and Nodal Officers of CFRC provided valuable insights into challenges and issues faced by stakeholders. The discussions further stressed on SOP's which are to be followed so that the obstacles can be minimized thereby maximizing benefits for the greater good of the community.
